This program is available to **Oswego County residents** through a partnership with the Sheriff's Office, 911 Emergency Communications Department, Oswego County Pioneer Search and Rescue Team and local law enforcement agencies.



Clients are fitted with a personalized wristband that emits a tracking signal 24 hours a day. Trained searchers use special equipment to track the signal and find the subject.
